


In 2019, New York State reported nearly 58,000 intimate partner violence (IPV) related offenses. That equates to more than 150 reported IPV incidents every day.



Of course, many victims choose not to report IPV-related offenses to criminal authorities. As a result, many cases of domestic violence go unreported.

According to the National Network to End Domestic Violence (NNEDV), NYS has had the highest demand for domestic violence services for 5 years in a row.

On just ONE DAY in 2020, 8,313 domestic violence survivors received help, such as emergency shelter, legal assistance, counseling, etc. Another 1,921 victims didn't receive the help they needed because of critical funding and staffing shortages.\*\*

NYS needs to prioritize funding for domestic violence programs to ensure that victims in need of shelter and other services are able to obtain the support they need immediately.
